337. 2016 Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Château de Vaudieu, Southern Rhône, France

Deep ruby red in colour, with a black cherry core. This wine has lively berry fruits on the nose, with a touch of liquorice and a hint of black pepper. On the palate, it's full-bodied and the ripe tannins are evident on the finish.

338. 2017 Amarone della Valpolicella Corte Giara, Italy Characteristic hints of black cherry and freshly-ground black pepper are followed by subtle herb nuances on the nose.
